Refreshments will be served and all proceeds will go to the Carlow/Kilkenny Homecare team, headed by Dr Ian Wilson, a family friend of Richard and Sally St. George.

"Kilrush House has one of the oldest, natural collections of snowdrops in the county and we want to give visitors the chance to enjoy them as much as we do. The blankets of snowdrops growing here each spring are truly spectacular. We encourage visitors to wear good walking shoes and really enjoy the grounds and woodlands of Kilrush House", said Sally St. George.
